

RULES

SWA - SWEDISH WATERFRONT AWARD

To increase the interest in contacting Swedish ham's the club SK7JC has published a diploma, "SWEDISH WATERFRONT AWARD", SWA.

To receive this diploma you should have confirmed radio contact with the Capital of Sweden, Stockholm, and as many of the 80 communes along the Swedish coast as possible.

DIPLOMA CLASSES

1:st class	SWA - ALL	Stockholm + 80 communes
2:nd class	SWA - 50	50 communes
3:rd class	SWA - 25	25 communes

SWA-All will be numbered in order of distribution.

All licensed radio amateurs and short-wave listeners, all over the world, are allowed to apply for the SWA-Diploma. All contacts have to be confirmed by QSL-cards or similar.

Contacts with permanent, portable and mobile stations after the 1:st of January 1982 are approved for SWA.

The commune list has been made by the committee of SK7JC.

The number in front of commune name makes it easier to find out which commune a certain QTH belongs to. There are many smaller societies in each commune.

In case of doubtfulness, ask for the commune number.

Portable and mobile stations have to inform of, portable or mobile QTH on the QSL-card.

RECORD BOOK.

SK7JC has put together a record book containing:

Complete rules, systematically ordered commune list with possibility to make notes about contacted stations, confirmed stations, dates and QTH's certificate application and a testimonial on which two licensed amateurs can certify that they have checked the QSL-cards of which the application concerns.
